



### MISSION VIEJO NADADORES

 One of the most decorated clubs in the history of United States Swimming and Diving. Over the past 12 years USA Swimming recognized the Top 20 Clubs in the country with their highest award the Gold Medal Club Award. The Nadadores have received this award 11 of 12 Years!

• The TOP USA Swimming Gold Medal club in California!

- The Dive Team has produced 8 Olympic Gold Medals, won 51 National Championships and is the only team ever to sweep all four World Championships in one year.
- The Swim Team has produced 47 National Team Championships, 22 World Records, 20 Olympic Medals, 5 Individual World Championship titles and 150 individual National Championships, as well as 91 American Records, 22 World Records and 138 Academic All-Americans over the years.


