Aid Program Policy

The Mission Viejo Nadadores Dive Program offers aid for families with a financial or familial need for assistance to help members stay actively involved in the sport of diving.

Aid Options Include: (please select desired option)

- Alternative payment plan for monthly dues (full dues amount to be paid over time)
- Discounted monthly dues rate
- Waiver of service hours (medical or military issues only)

Eligibility for Consideration:

Members considered for aid must:

1. Be a current MVNF Diving member that has been with the club for at least one year.
2. Demonstrate a clear financial need.
3. Have all accounts (billing and service hours) current over the past year.

Application Process:

1. Applicant to complete written application (attached)
2. Applicant must supply documentation to demonstrate financial need.
(Examples of supporting documentation are:)
 - Unemployment payment stub
 - Letter of termination/severance
 - Court Documents
 - Tax documents
 - Public assistance eligibility determination
 - Medical documentation
 - Military documentation
3. Submit application to the office staff in a sealed envelope marked:
Attention: Aid Sub-Committee
4. Application to be reviewed by Aid Sub-Committee with input (if needed) from Office Staff and Head Coach
5. Aid Sub-Committee recommends approval or denial to Dive Committee members
6. Dive Committee votes (simple majority carries), forwards to Foundation Board for approval
7. Sub-Committee member advises Applicant, office staff and Head Coach of decision
8. Applicant must immediately notify office staff of any material change in financial circumstances
9. Aid eligibility and updated documentation to be reviewed and re-approved at least every six months
10. Members of The Foundation, Dive Committee, Aid Sub – Committee, office staff or Head Coach is under **NO** obligation to share the basis or rationale behind any decision, for or against aid.
11. All information contained in the application and supporting documentation, if requested, is considered privileged and will not be shared with third parties.

Aid Options Exclude:

- Meet fees
- Team Photos
- Travel trip fees
- Team apparel
- Team sponsored activities/events
- Private lessons (fees may be negotiated with the coach)
- Banquet fees
- Dive-a-thon
