## The Venue

The Marguerite Aquatics Complex is located at 27474 Casta Del Sol, Mission Viejo, CA 92692.

The facility has four 1-meters, three 3-meters, 1,3,5,7.5, 10-meter platforms, sparger system, video replay, 3 dryland boards into a pit, 2 in-ground trampolines, and a spring floor.

### **Platforms**

Platform training must have someone calling the height, for use.

### **Dryland and Sparger System**

- The dryland boards will only be open during flighted workout times. Coaches must be present at the side of dryland for divers to use the dry boards.
- The floor will be open during all training times.
- The sparger system will not be available for use during the warmup or competition day



## **Schedule for Training**

Visiting teams may train on **Tuesday, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20, from 10:00 am – 4:00 pm**. Flights will be determined if necessary. If numbers do not warrant it, all warmups will be open.

## **Competition Format**

We will follow all World Aquatics Junior rules and regulations for all events The top 12 from all preliminary events will advance to finals in the afternoon.



All individual events will run as prelims/finals with the top 6 in each preliminary event moving on to finals in the afternoon. Countries may enter as many divers/synchro teams in an event they want. Only the top 2 from a country will advance to finals and only 2 synchro teams from a country can medal.

All synchro events will be straight finals.

- Foreign athletes must send USA Diving proof of insurance for each athlete and coach from their home federation prior to arrival.
- Coaches must register their intentions of participation on divemeets.com.

### **Dive Sheets**

- All entries must be made by the time of the technical meeting on May 20 at 4:00pm via diverseets.com.
- Dive entries and changes must be made at diversets.com. Change opportunities will end 3 hours prior to each event.

## **Dive Changes**

All athlete dive list changes, MUST be completed through divergets.com. Athletes may log in to their DiveMeets account to review and update their dive sheets within the timeline below:

- 1. Changes may be made online at no cost before 6pm the night prior to the first day's events, and before 12pm the day prior to all competition days thereafter.
- 2. Dive changes will no longer be accepted three hours prior to the event's start time
- 3. Dive changes will be billed directly on divergets.com for \$25 USD.

Shuttles will run from the hotel to the pool and back each day. There will be 4 shuttles (each way) each day on warm up days and 6 shuttles each way on competitions days at varying times.

### Credentials

• Credentials will be required to move into the pool area as well as the hospitality area. Please be sure to wear your credentials daily.


